Packraft Adventure Kvennavassdraget Hardangervidda Norway

Short description/content	<p>Norway's wilderness</p> <p>Multi-day expedition through the wilderness of the Hardangervidda</p> <p>Experience Norway's rugged beauty up close on a multi-day packraft trail through the pristine wilderness of Hardangervidda, Europe's largest plateau. Follow the wild Kvenna River as it winds through spectacular gorges and endless fell landscapes. Seven days, around 80 kilometres – on foot and by boat. This adventurous packrafting tour led by a certified wilderness and IRF guide, with a focus on safety, nature experience and real challenge.</p> <p>Around 80 km, no comfort, no reception – just you, your backpack, your boat. You carry everything yourself: tent, food, equipment. The reward? An intense outdoor experience, far away from civilization.</p> <p>A real adventure for those who don't want to consume nature, but really want to experience it. This packraft expedition in Norway is not for the lazy – but for real adventurers who don't just want to see wilderness, but feel it.</p>

Meeting place	Skinnarbu Skinnarbu National Park Hotel, Møsvatn, 3660 Rjukan, Norwegen 12.07.2026 10.00 a.m.
Expiration	<p>We meet at 10.00 a.m. in the parking lot of the National Park Hotel Skinnarbu. Then a short introduction to our packraft tour. Material check, organization Transfer to the starting point.</p> <p>Transfer from Skinnarbu to the starting point about 130km.</p> <p>If everything works out, we climb up to our first camp site on the same day.... From now on, the weather and our own condition determine the further course. We have 7 days to get to Skinnarbu.</p>
Requirements	<p>If you're ready to carry your own adventure – literally and figuratively – and want to actively experience Norway's wilderness, you've come to the right place.</p> <p>Participating in the Packraft Trail Hardangervidda requires a good physical condition, solid outdoor experience and the willingness to move independently in remote wilderness for several days – on foot and on the water.</p> <p>Requirements:* Navigate flowing waters of class WW II in packraft or kayak* Surefootedness and endurance for longer hiking stages with full luggage (approx. 25 kg)* Independent handling of equipment, camp construction and food*</p>

	<p>Willingness to camp in the open air, in all weathers* Minimum age 16 years (accompanied by an adult supervisor)</p> <p>Own equipment required:* Packraft equipment incl. paddle, vest, helmet, packing system* Personal camping equipment (tent, sleeping system, stove etc.)* Packrafts with an integrated transport solution, such as a TIZIP zipper, are recommended to store equipment safely and water-protected in the boat.</p>
Materials	Good hiking boots, rain gear, thermal jacket, food for 8 days, stove and dishes, tent, sleeping bag, complete packraft equipment
